- Write an imaginative short story or poem inspired by the music. Your writing should NOT be an essay or musical analysis. TELL US A STORY!

Only one entry per person.
The story or poem must not exceed 500 words.
DEADLINE for submissions is JULY 1, 2010.

Indicate which piece of music inspired your work. Also include your name, age/grade, telephone number or email address. Submissions may be typed or handwritten and can be mailed or emailed.

The competition is open to any child **aged 8-14** or enrolled in **grades 3-8** as of May 1, 2010 and who meets one of the following requirements:

- resides in Staunton City, or
- attends public or private school in Staunton City, or
- studies with a music teacher in Staunton City.

- One winner for each musical selection will be chosen to receive a \$50 gift card from Pufferbellies.
- One honorable mention will be chosen for each musical selection to receive a \$25 gift card from Pufferbellies.
- All participating students will receive a small prize from Pufferbellies.
